Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by KMCH-FM.

Description of Activities:

Internship Program –

KMCH-FM annually conducts an on-going internship program to give high school and college students hands-on experience in radio broadcasting. The stations invited students to apply for the various internship opportunities through recruitment at the local high school guidance offices and speech coaches.

Four (4) interns took part in the program during the reporting period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021. Interned with the programming department during this time period as a paid part-time employee.

One (1) college student interned with the programming department as a paid part-time employee running the control board during sports broadcasts, Sunday Morning Board Operations, and live play by play broadcasts.

School Career Fairs/Events –

KMCH-FM annually contacts area schools and offers to participate in any school career fairs and events that may be scheduled. Various employees participate in the events, depending on the specialty the students are most interested in. No School Career Fairs/Educational Events were scheduled during the reporting period of October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2021 due to COVID-19 concerns.

One tour of the radio station was given to Area Residential Care Clients.

Communication & Radio Skills Training:

During the reporting period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021: Production Director Rob Edwards assisted area students to create scripts and record messages about Homecoming activities, 4H week, FFA week, Red Ribbon week, High School Senior graduation Salutes, Catholic Schools week.
